India is currently the fourth largest economy in the world, with a GDP of approximately \$4.187 trillion. This represents a significant milestone in India's economic growth trajectory. ISRO is the 6th largest space agency in the world and holds an exceptional success rate. With over 400 private space companies, India ranks 5th globally in the number of space companies and India is 5th amongst spacefaring nations having end-to-end capabilities in space research. India holds the 4th position in global military strength, according to the 2025 Global Firepower (GFP) index. India's higher education sector has significantly improved its global standing, notably in the QS World University Rankings. India holds the 4th position globally in research output. In the latest rankings, India secured the 4th position globally in terms of representation, with 54 institutions featured, including 12 IITs. India has a large and growing higher education sector with around 1,200 universities and university-level institutions. The number of colleges in India is even larger, exceeding 42,825. This includes a variety of institutions like state universities, central universities, deemed universities, and private universities.

Our Prime Minister in his address to the nation on the 79th Independence Day from the iconic Red Fort in Delhi, today, the 15th August, 2025, said that 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' (self-reliant India) is the foundation of 'Viksit Bharat' (a developed India).


Vikram Sarabhai Birthday Celebration


Induction Program – Talk on Anti-Drug, Anti-Ragging & Cyber Security


Induction Program – Academic Overview


Induction Program – A Forgotten Clue...?


Induction Program – Tech Awakening: AI, Skills & You


Student Development Activities at STCET




Survival, Strength & Self: The Art of Becoming




Asaad Sena: Anti-Drug Awareness Session








Road Safety Awareness Induction Program Day 6


79th Independence Day Celebration at STCET
